Problem: CQC have stated that TSD are not providing pregnant women with enough information/education about smoking during pregnancy. This is important as smoking during pregnancy increases the risk of stillbirth. One of NHS Improvements 'Maternity and Neonatal Health Safety Collaborative' (which TSD are part of) goals is to reduce the number of stillbirths by 20% by 2020.



Goal: Create a patient information video to educate pregnant women about the dangers of smoking during pregnancy and signpost to smoking cessation support to reduce the number of pregnant smokers in Torbay.
